Arriving at School:

Prior to arriving at school, the student should take the COVID symptom checker found at https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLScj9_ZARnk7aIP2wp_AwI3JksTmeM-AEQIEFekPmheQ3x-Q-w/viewform. Should the student feel ill or have a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, he/she should stay home from school. *Students should notify their instructor of their illness and should stay home 10 days (returning on day 11, symptom free with no fever) or until the student has a negative COVID test.*

Students will arrive to school wearing masks and these shall remain on throughout the duration of their day on campus. Masks are required at all times while students are on campus, both indoors and outdoors.

Students may park in the back parking lot and enter through normal entrance points.

Students who are dropped off at school by non-students, should ensure that the drivers remain in their vehicles when dropping off or picking up.

All visitors to campus must wear masks at all times and check into the office prior to entering any classrooms or other facilities

Movement within the school- Passing Periods, Nutrition Break or Lunch:

While social distance is not required, during breaks and non-instructional times, it is recommended that students maintain 3 to 6 feet of distance. Large groups of students should not congregate in common areas.

The student break room will be open, but students should purchase food and beverages and not congregate in the area for extended periods of time.

Dismissal Time:

When not in class or conducting school business, students and visitors should not congregate on campus. Students should exit their classrooms at the end of instruction and leave the campus in a timely manner.
