

# FREMONT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

**BACKGROUND:** The Fremont Unified School District (FUSD) Board of Education has established a Technology Advisory Committee (TAC) the purpose of which is to advise and make recommendations to the Board, Superintendent, and the District management staff as appropriate regarding technology matters.

**VISION STATEMENT:**

- FUSD will educate, challenge, and inspire all students, staff, parents and community members. We will prepare students with the skills required to adapt and succeed in an ever-changing global society.
- Contemporary technology and information literacy are integral to teaching, learning, assessment and communication in FUSD.
- We are committed to on going professional development and effective community engagement to enable the vision to become reality.
- Implementation will be equitable, cost-effective and timely.
- This vision is supported by a robust, dynamic and sustainable infrastructure resulting in measurable student success and improved overall organizational effectiveness and efficiency.

**FUNCTIONS OF THE TAC:**

- Act as advisors on the state of technology within the District;
- Perform research and report on action items specifically assigned to the Committee by the Board;
- Review, develop and submit technology recommendations including current use of technology within the District and future technology needs of the District;
- Committee reports and recommendations to the Board will be included as agenda items for the Board's consideration;
- Communicate recommendations and efforts to the public; and/or
- Serve as a working committee or appoint sub-committees as necessary to study needed technology-related programs and services of the District, and serve as an active participant regarding the District technology plan.

**MEMBERSHIP:** There are 16 seats on the TAC. Eight seats are for community members and the other eight are for FUSD staff members and Union representation. The Board appoints community members and the Superintendent appoints staff members.

**TERM:** The term of an appointment is two years. A member may be eligible for reappointment.

**COMMITMENT:** Members are required to attend periodic meetings of the full Committee once per month, from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM on the first Monday of each month. Additional time commitments may be necessary for those members appointed to subcommittee work.

**DISCLOSURE:** Each individual who serves as an appointed member on the Board of Education's Committees/Commissions will be required to file a statement of economic interest (Form 700). The statement will disclose the member's interests in investments, real property, and income is designated reportable by the Political Reform Act of 1974.
