Dear Mattos Parents and Community Members,

Thank you to parents and families who have been following the health guidelines when children are sick. Your compliance with keeping students home when they have a fever, have been actively ill and need to be symptom free for at least 48 hours is helping our site. Our Team at Mattos has been following the health guidelines when we are sick as well and our custodial team is also doing deep cleaning. We are all being constantly vigilant about working to have a school that is as germ free as possible. Cold and flu season has been particularly rough this year and it only through everyone's diligence that we can all be healthy and productive.

As we move into March we will be doing GATE Testing for selected 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students next week and ELPAC Testing for English Language Learners all month. ELPAC Is the English Language Proficiency Assessment for California. This is the annual test that replaced CELDT or the California English Language Development Test. ELPAC, like CELDT measures students'

English Language proficiency and allows us to see what progress our English Language Learners are making in reading, writing, listening and speaking.

Please be aware that our annual SBAC Testing for grades 3-6 will begin in April immediately after our Spring Break. The SBAC Testing focuses on English Language Arts and Math in grades 3, 4, 5 and 6 with 5<sup>th</sup> grade also being tested in Science. Testing will start April 29<sup>th</sup> and go through the first week of June. It is important that students be present for testing as it provides valuable information on student and site progress. Please mark your calendars!

Stay healthy and keep up the good work of monitoring children. We appreciate your care and consideration of our community of learners.
