During the presentation she asked participants to think about and write down their ideas for each item, on a form that she provided. Then they broke into groups to take turns sharing their ideas, and discussing common themes which they noted on the form. They compared the number of English learners and Reclassified students during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 school year. They also reviewed the Reclassification criteria. They explained that beginning in the 2017-18 school year, Reclassified students will be monitored for 4 years rather than 2 years as was previously required by the State.
