PAINTER

DEFINITION:

Under general direction, to perform skilled painting work in the redecorating and maintenance painting of school facilities; and to perform job-related duties as required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Depending on the assignment, duties may include but are not limited to the following.

Uses brush, roller, or spray gun, both conventional and airless types, in applying paint, varnish, shellac, enamel, lacquer, or other protective or decorative finishes to various surfaces such as wood, metal, glass, plaster, stucco, woodboard, brick, and cement.

Scrapes, sands, fills, sandblasts and prepares surfaces for painting, repainting or wallpapering.

Mixes paints of various consistencies and colors for exterior smooth and rough plaster and concrete work.

Applies slating on chalk boards and striping to parking lots and playgrounds.

Cares for painting, sandblasting, slating and striping equipment such as brushes, solutions, sprayers, sandblasters and ladders, etc.

Erects and moves scaffolding and platforms.

Makes cost and time estimates and orders materials needed.

Lays out work and maintains records of work performed.

Applies wallpaper.

Makes minor applications of glazing compound to wood frames in preparing the surface for painting.

Directs the work of assigned help.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

Safe work practices including OSHA regulations, as they relate to the position;

Building codes and regulations as they relate to the position;

The tools, materials, standard practices and processes of the painting trade;

Methods of preparing different surfaces for painting and repainting;

Stripping and bleaching chemicals;

Rust neutralizers and primers.

Ability to:

Estimate the scope of each work assignment and secure the necessary tools and equipment to complete the assignment;

Estimate the proper paint requirements for all types of surfaces;

Mix, match, and apply paints to all types of surfaces;

Erect and work from riggings and scaffolding:

Read and write English at a level sufficient to successfully perform the duties associated with the position;

Identify workplace hazards and/or unsafe conditions and take appropriate action to correct same;

Perform heavy physical labor including but not limited to the ability to lift up to 50 lbs. without assistance and up to 100 lbs. with appropriate tools or assistance:

Understand and carry out oral and written directions;

Establish and maintain cooperative working relationship with those contacted in the course of work.

Education: Combination of training and experience equivalent to completion of a full four-year apprenticeship program in

the painter trades.

Experience: One year of journey-level experience performing redecorating and maintenance painting on a variety of

materials and surfaces.

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATES:

Possession of a valid California driver's license with no restrictions which would preclude driving on the job is a continuous requirement.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

In accordance with California law and the Education Code, position incumbents must maintain a conviction free Dept. of Justice background record which is relevant to the position.
